## Press Release


Delhi School of Journalism (DSJ) was established by University of Delhi to provide a quality media education opportunity to 120 students each year in English and Hindi medium at an affordable cost for the Five Year Integrated Programme in Journalism (FYIP). The number of applicants has grown tremendously in two years (12000 applicants were registered in 2018 as against 2100 in 2017) for admission.

The students are provided with a neat and clean class room with decent furniture. The School has 36 visiting faculty to provide specialised knowledge in the subject areas of the curriculum. The school also organizes media workshops and field visits (22 in 2018-19 & 46 in 2018-19) as per our commitment to new pedagogy adopted at DSJ. All students of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semester have been provided with Laptops and almost all other students are having a Lap top each from the Laptop Bank created by DSJ. They have the opportunity to use various lab facilities in the university. DSJ has a digitally classified library.

Twenty five per cent of students of each batch and each sections/medium are provided with the fee concessions of 20 % to 80 % of the tuition fee.

Students are increasingly being exposed to various national and international new agencies like Sputnik Pro, EFE, and persons of repute line Adi Rawal (US), Robert Bolton ( Australia), Geysa Gonzalez (Ukraine), Pervaiz Alam (England) etc.

The students are also actively engaged in professional production of Magazines, newsletter, and lab magazines and ECA activities.
