Students of Delhi School of Journalism attended a seminar by Dr. Sabine Schmidt Lauff of Hamburg University on Friday, 29 September 2017. Prof. Lauff was delivering a key note address in the International Autumn School conducted by Department of Adult Continuing Education and Extension, University of Delhi – an Indo German Project from 16 – 30 September 2017. It also provided the students of DSJ an opportunity to interact with students from Germany and Bangladesh.

In her talk titled, "Contextualization within Marginalization in Adult Learning and Education", Professor Lauff gave a detailed analysis of the education systems

in Germany, Europe and the Indian subcontinent. Dr Lauff helped the students in understanding the different aspects of contemporary education systems through well researched studies and statistics. The level of adult participation in education in these regions was also discussed. Dr. Lauff emphasized on the differences between the individual, social needs and the market (economic) needs of the prospective students (of adult education) using concrete examples from the respective countries.
