At the same time, he refrained from calling himself a journalist and preferred to be called a 'content creator'. Not only, did he explain the way a news presenter should be, but also emphasized on the importance of speaking the language you speak the best. Mr. Sardana shared some psychological mantras and body language hacks with the students. Taking a subtle dig at 'some channels' and

'some anchors' whose 'absurd' cries merely about getting abused on twitter are futile; he used this opportunity to explain why acknowledging the viewers' sentiments is necessary for a channel.



At the end of the session, he was bombarded with some not so easy to answer questions from fierce nascent journalists. The seminar concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Manasvini M. Yogi, the OSD of Delhi School of Journalism.
