**Qualifications for Assistant Professor Journalism/ related area and languages on Guest basis (Academic Category) for Bilingual teaching as per the UGC regulations on minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers in Universities and Colleges.**

1. Eligibility: Instruction in the course is bilingual. Applicants should be comfortable imparting instruction in English as well as Hindi with ease besides meeting the criteria in A or B

**A.**

- i) Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.



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ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. Candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

**B.** The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:  
(i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)(ii)the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU)of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table3B) for Colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

2. Candidates from the **professional category** for appointment as Assistant Professor on Guest basis will be considered in respect of the technical and professional competence required for the course/paper and the ability of the applicants to deliver the required skill sets by the



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Selection Committee.

3. Appointments shall be made **for four months only at a time**.
4. Short listed candidates will be called for an interview as per the details notified.
5. All candidates are required to carry their latest CV along with the self-attested copies of certificates at the time of interview.
6. No TA/DA will be paid for the interview.

**NOTE:**

1. Application must reach through google form by **June 20, 2024**.
2. Reservation in hiring of Guest Faculty shall be as per the policy of University of Delhi.
3. Applicant should mark clearly their preference of courses based on their competency/qualification
4. Teaching assignment will be allocated to guest faculty as per the semestral requirement.
5. List of candidates as per the interview schedule shall be published on the website (DSJ and DU) Website i.e. [www.dsj.du.ac.in](http://www.dsj.du.ac.in) & [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in) and no individual communication to the candidate will be made.
6. Interviews will be held in offline/physical mode only.
