## **DISSERTATION GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Students of FYIPJ Semester 10<sup>th</sup> and MJ Semester 4th, as per the course structure, are required to do a project work/production or write a Dissertation which carries 12 credits equal to 300 marks.
- 2. Each student is allotted a co-supervisor/supervisor from amongst the faculty or an external one as is decided by the committee with Hon. Director as supervisor.
- 3. A tentative list of broad topics is provided as a support to help choose the area of work. These broad areas are suggestive only. Faculty/ students can bring in newer issues with justification for the work.
- 4. DSJ shall continue to develop focus areas for cooperative efforts and focused out come in years to come based on the disciplinary requirements and developmental priorities.
- 5. Students are required to submit a 3 to 4 pages synopsis on the topic to the Cosupervisor on 22/03/2024 as part of the first stage of evaluation. The Committee comprising of supervisor (Honorary Director) and Co-Supervisors of Dissertation shall finalize the topic.
- 6. The mid-term presentation and evaluation will be to the committee on 22/04/2024 at from 9:30 AM to till 11:30 AM.
- 7. The last date of Final submission of the dissertation/production is on 10/05/2024 till 5:30 PM.
- 8. The final Viva voce examination of the dissertation/production will be held on 13 /05/2024 from 9:30 AM to 4:30 PM
- 9. The date of submission will be strictly followed in accordance with the examination schedule of University of Delhi.
